CONDITIONS

- 1. Player must be under 18 on the day of the event
- 2. All players must have a current Golf Australia handicap limit boys 36 and girls 36.
- 3. All entries and payments to be made online via MiTournament.
- 4. Entry Fee is \$40.00 including GST. Includes a light lunch after the tournament.
- 5. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded for late withdrawal.
- 6. The Gross Winner, and all other events, will be decided by a countback.
- 7. Motorised buggies or caddies not permitted.
- 8. Players may win only one major trophy.
- 9. Players losing a complete hole must call the following group through undue slow play may be penalised.
- 10. The tournament is under the control of the Burleigh Golf Club Match Committee.
- 11. Players must report to the Starter at least 15 minutes prior to tee off time.
- 12. The Match Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any reason, either shorten the competition or reschedule the event. In the event of a tie in any competition, standard Golf Australia count back conditions will apply.

 13. In case of excess entries being submitted, the highest handicaps may be subject to ballot.

2023 GREG NORMAN JUNIOR MASTERS QUALIFYING CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

An Open qualifier is an event whereby any junior who is a **financial member of Junior Golf Queensland** under 18 years of age as of the first day of play at the 2023 Greg Norman Junior Masters, regardless of where they live, are eligible to qualify for the Greg Norman Junior Masters by winning the gross event in his/ her age division. Juniors wanting to qualify for the 2023 Greg Norman Junior Masters must:

- 1. Be a financial member of Junior Golf Queensland prior to the commencement/playing in any qualifying event across the state
- 2. Have the best gross score in their age division (17, 15 or 13 and under boys and girls) as determined by their age as of the first day of play at the Greg Norman Junior Masters, starting on Monday 11 December 2023, i.e. if you are 15 now, but turn 16 before the first day of play, you will compete in the 17 and under age division. In the event of a tie, the GA countback system must be used unless the tournament conditions stipulate ties are decided by a playoff. **Other**

Qualifying Conditions and Information:

- 1. Juniors (boys and girls) will compete in either of the following age divisions:
- 17 years and under
- 15 years and under
- 13 years and under

Juniors will participate in the age division as determined by their age as of the first day of play at the Greg Norman Junior Masters, i.e. if you are 15 when you qualify, but turn 16 before the first day of play at the GNJM, you will compete in the 17 and under age division.

- 2. Once a junior has turned 18 years of age or is turning 18 years of age before the first day of play, he/she is not eligible to qualify for the Greg Norman Junior Masters.
- 3. Juniors can only qualify once for the Greg Norman Junior Masters. In the instance of a qualified player returning the best gross on a qualifying day, the runner-up will then qualify or the next best gross score of a player who has not already qualified.
- 4. In normal circumstances there must be a minimum of six players in each age division per qualifying event. If this is not achievable the organiser of the event must consult with Junior Golf Queensland. In the instance where a qualifying event does not have enough boys/ girls in each age division, boys/girls will compete in one event over all age divisions and two qualifying spots are played for, i.e. the two best gross scores.
- 5. The Tournament Committee may at its discretion issue a special invitation to any player who has performed well and is under 18 years of age as at first day of play to participate in the Greg Norman Junior Masters. (Numbers permitting)
- 6. Districts/Clubs must return a full list of gross scores (in countback order) to JGQ on the day of the event or within two days after completion of the event.
- 7. Players must comply with the tournament conditions set by the Districts/Clubs for each of their individual qualifying event/s, i.e. if the conditions state Caddies are not permitted, you must comply with this rule.
- 8. Junior Golf Queensland is not responsible for the running of the Districts/Clubs qualifying events.
- 9. Junior Golf Queensland's role is to record the gross results, update the website with a list of qualifiers, determine the age division for each of the juniors qualifying and contact them regarding their entry into the event.
