# 2019 EASTER TOURNAMENT

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY & CONDITIONS OF PLAY

### 1: THE CHAMPIONSHIP:

The Tournament will be played over 3 days on Friday 19<sup>th</sup>, Sat 20<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> April 2019 – with a Stableford (& a Mixed Medley in conjunction) on the Friday on the River Course, followed by a Stroke round for Men on the Saturday on the West, and a Stroke round for Men on the Sunday on the River course. There will be daily prizes for Gross & Nett for each of the 3 days. The player returning the Best Gross Score for the 36 Hole Stroke rounds on Saturday & Sunday becomes the Overall Winner of the 2019 Easter Tournament.

### 3: TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:

The Championship will be under the management and control of a Tournament Committee – the composition of this Committee to be determined by the Coolangatta & Tweed Heads Golf Club Match Committee. The Tournament Committee reserve the right to [a] fix and/or alter starting times, [b] in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the contest or fix another day/venue, [c] vary any conditions should they deem it advisable, [d] reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore.

### 4: ENTRIES:

- 4.1 The CTHGC Easter Tournament is open to all amateur golfers with an Australian Handicap who are members of a golf club affiliated through their District Golf Association with the GA, or other State/National Golf Associations.
- 4.2 Entries must be received by the Golf manager, Coolangatta & Tweeds Heads Golf Club, via email – [neil@cooltweedgolf.com.au](mailto:neil@cooltweedgolf.com.au) – or by mail to PO Box 6010, Tweed Heads South NSW 2486 by 5pm on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> April 2019.
- 4.3 The prescribed **Nomination Fee of \$99** [incl. GST] for all 3 days, or \$35 a day **must** accompany the nomination form at the time. For further information, Please phone the Coolangatta & Tweeds Heads Golf Club office on 07-55 244 544.
- 4.4 **Do not send cash in the mail** – the Coolangatta & Tweed Heads Golf Club will not accept responsibility for any cash sent that is not received. Faxed entries will be accepted with Credit Card payments.
- 4.5 Once the draw is completed there will be no refund of entry fees to players who withdraw from the event. The Draw will be available 2 days prior to event, and once finalized the draw will be placed on our website.

### 5: RULES:

The rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews will apply together with such Local Rules as are approved by the Tournament Committee.

### 6: PROTESTS:

The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final in all matters and in the absence of a full committee; such members as may be present at the time may give a decision. Any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Tournament Committee. Protests must be lodged in writing with the Tournament Committee no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of the days play.

### 7: TIES:

In the event of a tie for the Gross Championship Event [only] the result will be settled by a countback. The breaking of ties for all events/trophies will be determined by use of the Australian Count-back System. If a winner is still not able to be determined after the countback system is applied, then there will be dual winners.

### 8: PACE OF PLAY:

Rules 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to players in such groups who, by their pace, contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

**9: DRAW AND STARTING TIMES:**

A draw for the Tournament will be published on our website [www.cooltweedgolf.com.au](http://www.cooltweedgolf.com.au)

Competitors **must** be ready to start at the appointed time and in the order arranged by the Tournament Committee. Players must report to the starter 15 minutes before allocated starting time and be prepared to tee off when called. Rule 6-3a provides "The Players shall start at the time laid down by the Committee". The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However it is a condition of this Tournament that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the players arrive at their starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of their starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole, instead of disqualification.

**10: BALL:**

It will be obligatory for all competitors in this Event to play with a ball which is named in the current list of conforming Golf Balls issued by the R&A. Copies of this list can be obtained from [www.usga.org](http://www.usga.org) or for viewing at the Course. Penalty for breach of condition is Disqualification.

**11: USE OF MOTORISED VEHICLES:** Carts are allowed for all events

**12: MOBILE PHONE:** The use of a mobile phone by players during the play of any competition round is prohibited.

**13: MEASURING DEVICES:** Measuring devices allowed for distance only, breach of this rule **disqualification**.

**14: PUBLICITY:** The Coolangatta & Tweed Heads Golf Club may arrange publicity before, during and /or after this Tournament. It is a condition of entry that all players assent to references to them and pictures of them in practice and play being published via any medium [including the internet].

**15: PRIVACY:**

The Coolangatta & Tweed Heads Golf Club may retain the personal details [ie: name, address, handicap] of entries in this Tournament on its records. The purpose of doing so is such that information on other future events conducted by the Coolangatta & Tweed Heads Golf Club [or other parties] can be forwarded as deemed appropriate by the Coolangatta & Tweed Heads Golf Club. This information will not be available to any other organisation. Any person may have their details removed from this database by phoning the Tournament Director Coolangatta & Tweed Heads Golf Club on 07 55 244 544.

**16: DRESS REGULATIONS:** It is a requirement of this Tournament that all players must comply with the dress standards of Coolangatta & Tweed Heads Golf Club. The Club will permit the wearing of short socks if players wish to wear shorts. Denim trousers or denim shorts are not permitted. Players not conforming to the dress requirements of the Courses will not be permitted to take their place in the field.

**17: TROPHIES:**

A trophy will be awarded to the Overall Winner of the 2019 Easter Tournament.

Other prizes will be allocated for the Friday Stableford and for Daily Prizes for the Stroke Event, plus Gross and Nett Prizes for the Overall Event

**18.** This event will be limited to one trophy per person
