INFORMATION FOR ALL PLAYERS:

DATE TO BE PLAYED: Monday 17 October, 2022

COURSE: Palmer Colonial

STARTERS/MARSHAL: GCDGA Executive members

FORMAT: All play will be in 4's. Match play in accordance with the rules/conditions specified. If in doubt please ask.

LOCAL RULES: To be read from the scorecard (pro shop) and any additional on the noticeboard.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: These will need to be booked in advance through the pro shop and will either be at the player or individual club's costs

TOSS: A GCDGA official who will be acting as starter will conduct a toss for honour prior to the first group teeing off

TEAM SHEET: A completed team sheet showing name, golf link number, frozen handicap and adjusted handicap is be provided to the GCDGA official 15 minutes prior to tee off.

TEE OFF ORDER: Players 6&5 from each team/Players 4&3 from each team/Players 2&1 from each team. Groups will be at 7 minute intervals

TEES: Senior Pennant Finals – Blue Tee

Super Senior Pennant Finals – White Tee

TIMES: Senior Pennant- Division 1 Tee off from 1st Tee at 7.12am

Division 2 Tee off from 1st Tee at 7.33am

Super Senior Pennant: Division 1 Tee off from 10th Tee at 7.12am

Division 2 Tee off from 10th Tee at 7.33am

SLOW PLAY: Players must maintain their position. Slow will not be tolerated (on a one warning basis) and will be monitored by GCDGA executive

MOTORISED CARTS: These are provided by the GCDGA to all players on a shared cart basis and are to be collected from the proshop, prior to tee off. Players may walk if they wish.

RANGE BALLS: These are available at the hut vending machine at the player's individual expense.

PRESENTATIONS/HOSPITALITY: The GCDGA will provide two large platters of food per final. These will be served prior to the pennant presentation.
